VI. PERSONS PLACED ON AGENDA: 1. ANDY LONG—HERE ON GARBAGE ON PEOPLES' PROPERTY AND WHAT CAN BE DONE. EXAMPLES ARE LAWRENCE CLARK, EAN'S, MARSH PROPERTY, HOUSE THAT WAS BURNED AND NEVER CLEANED UP. SOLICITOR STATED TWP. DOES NOT HAVE A NUISANCE ORD, TWP HAS TAKEN A HANDS OFF APPROACH. IT COMES DOWN TO ENFORCING IT, TWP HAS NO POLICE NOR A CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER TO ENFORCE IT. TWP WOULD HAVE TO CONTRACT TO PROSECUTE. BONNIE ASKED IF THERE WAS SOMETHING WITH THE STATE.
